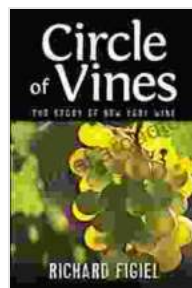

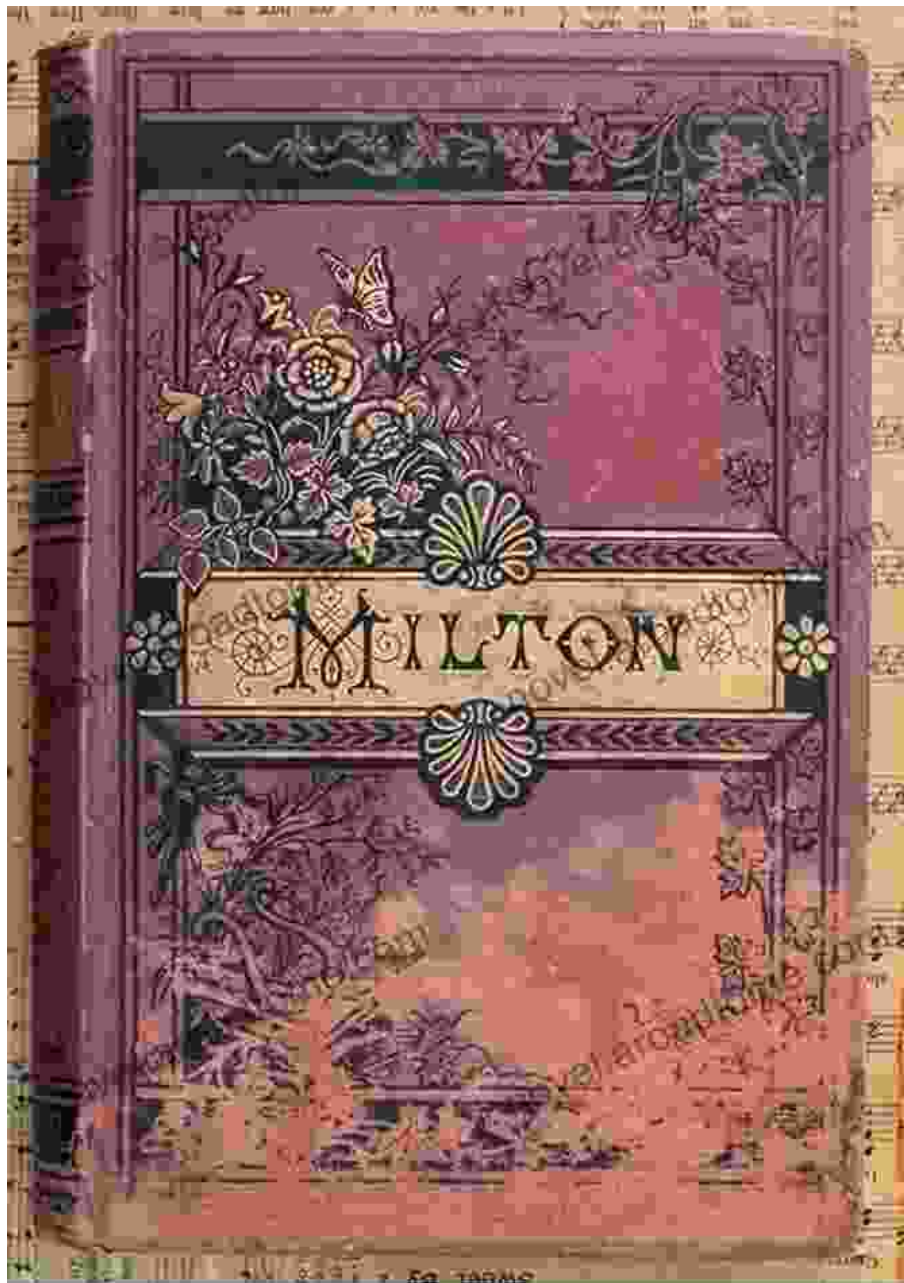
A Thriving Present

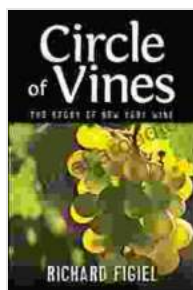
